Palama Settlement is one of the few settlement houses left in the country offering education, recreation, counseling, music and arts training and job preparation. The son of Palama Settlement founders James Arthur and Ragna Rath, Rath was raised in the settlement, attended Springfield College in Massachusetts and returned to Honolulu to become athletic director and coach at Palama Settlement. "He was really great at what he did," recalled younger brother Robert Rath. "He was very dedicated to Palama Settlement." Robert Rath, 10 years his brother's junior, swam and dove under Rath's tutelage and became an interscholastic champion. Rath also

started soccer teams at the settlement, created an annual circus and developed a successful Junior Olympic squad along with famed Honolulu sportswriter Ezra Crane that dominated competition on a national level. After serving in the military during World War II, Rath moved to Little Rock, where he organized and operated a junior golf program for many years. "He couldn't keep his hands off organizing and helping," said Robert Rath.
