Norio Yamauchi, a Big Island small businessman and founding member of the postwar Japanese Chamber of Commerce in Hilo, died Monday Jan 13, 2003 at his home in Hilo. He was 89. Yamauchi was born Sept. 25, 1913 in Hilo, and attended Hilo High School until he was orphaned at the age of 16. As the oldest sibling, Yamauchi went to work at Waiakea sugar mill to support his two younger brothers and two younger sisters, and never completed high school. Even without education, he had a knack for business, and began selling insurance and dealing in real estate in the years leading up to World War II. But he had to start over after the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, said his sister Yuriko Yamauchi. Norio Yamauchi was interned at Kilauea Military Camp for three months, apparently because he was regarded as a leader in the Japanese business community, said Yuriko. During the war years the family resorted to buying and selling grocery items, eggs, woven lauhala and other items to bring in money, she said. downtown Hilo. The Japanese Chamber of Commerce had been dissolved during the war, but in 1952 about eight businessmen on the Big Island were tapped to launch a postwar Japanese chamber, including Yamauchi.
